



Outline of the ICN Merger Cooperation Framework


- 1. Registration with icn@jftc.go.jp and getting the Contact list


- ◆ Survey questionnaire was sent in September 2018
- ◆ Response Rate: 51.3% (40 / 78 authorities)







Experiences of using the Framework

- > The Framework has been used for;
 - enforcement cooperation for merger review on particular cases
 - gathering past case examples on novel issues
 - reference for development/improvement of merger review systems [Canada, Kenya, Japan, anonymous authorities.]
- In enforcement cooperation, the authorities have exchanged information such as market definition, theories of harms, remedies, etc. [Kenya, anonymous authorities]
- In addition, it is useful to use it for gathering information of other jurisdiction's system for law amendment, etc. [Kenya, etc.]



Improvement of the Framework

	Suggestions from the survey	Possible improvements
√	Promote understanding of how to use the Framework (73% authorities)	Further promotion such as creating and distributing a Flyer
√	Increase the number of competition authorities participating in the Framework (37.5% authorities)	
√	Provide a list describing the category of information which can be exchanged through the Framework (70% authorities)	Create and provide a Information Category List and a Information Request Form
√	Provide a form which can be used for initial contact with other authorities (42.5% authorities)	
√	Include in the contact list whether the agency has an online public register of the mergers under review and include a link	Include link to public case information in the contact list

Other

- ✓ Use direct contact details of case team or relevant division for merger review in the contact list
- ✓ Review framework in light of recent MWG work to consider whether new language or new terms are appropriate for it
