Back to basics : what facts in the digital world are we trying to tackle?

A situation :

- of exploitation enabled by a significant imbalance of powers, asymetry of information and regulation
- Relative domination (and not necessarily dominance) of one undertaking;
- Vulnerability of an ecosystem of business users (individually and/or collectively) to access end н. users;
- Subject to a set of abnormal, unfair, and/or excessive restrictions;
- Without objective, necessary and proportionate justifications; н.
- And which may harm actually or potentially one or several market(s) functioning. .

Imbalance of powers: how digital exploitation may be addressed?

Beyond abuse of dominance, a renewed interest in other legal tools (existing or new):

- Vertical restrictions when imposed through contractual provisions c.f. revised EU vertical regulation and guidelines and its update on platform economy issues;
- New targeted regulation: the Digital market act and other regulatory initiatives arount the world;
- Economic dependence: a multifaceted concept with renewed interest in the digital world -Fairness
 - Concept was absent from EU until first appearance in the 2022 guidelines on art. 101 TFUE for collective agreement by solo self employed platform workers;
 - The concept exists in several EU member States (Germany, France, Spain etc.); The French Apple distribution case : in concreto analysis, of a set of criteria, can be both individual and collective (coping with digital ecosystems). Abuse can materialize in significantly imbalanced terms and conditions, asymetry of information;

A truly global reach with business partners affected everywhere and whole ecosystems impacted

- Demultiplication of national litigation (private and/or public enforcement)
 variety of outcomes, with
 geographical limitations reducing efficiency;
- Complexification through venue provisions and choice of applicable law

 need to ensure effective access to a judge somewhere in the world, to enable efficient outcomes;
- Converging views in national reports ► see mobile ecosystems and app stores (Japan, US, UK notably);
