### Development of the New Procedure

From the perspective of <u>making the New Leniency Program more</u> <u>effective</u>, which was introduced under the Amended Act on Prohibition of Private Monopolization and Maintenance of Fair Trade (the "AMA"), etc.

The new procedure purports to return the objects recording the confidential communications between an enterprise and an attorney regarding legal advice on an act alleged to be a violation to which the leniency program may apply immediately without Investigators having access to the contents thereof when it is confirmed that they are stored appropriately and satisfy certain other conditions.




## What kind of investigation will be covered?

The procedure is designed to cover <u>Fair Trade Commission's</u> <u>administrative investigations</u> into an <u>Alleged Act in Violation to Which the Leniency Program may Apply</u>, but not to compulsory investigations.



## [Objects]

- Confidential communications between an enterprise and an attorney (interviews, phone calls, emails, etc.)
- With regard to legal advice on an Alleged Act in Violation to Which the Leniency Program may Apply



This is called "Specified Communications".

→ The procedure covers the objects (documents, etc.) recording contents of Specified Communications.




### [Method of Custody]

### There are 3 key points for custody.

(i) Indication

(ii) Specific place of storage





(iii) Restriction on the scope of the persons who know the contents



- Investigators do not access the contents of the objects recording contents of Specified Communications.
- Differences in opinions between investigators and enterprises are to be avoided.



#### Steps to return the objects

When a place where the objects recording contents of Specified Communications are stored becomes the target of an on-site inspection (for an Alleged Act in Violation to Which the Leniency Program may Apply)

- During an on-site inspection
- Orally inform an investigator of the intention to apply for determination procedures for the objects recording contents of Specified Communications
- (ii) Submit the application to the investigator
- (iii) The objects recording contents of Specified Communications are treated as those that are subject to a submission order, separately from other objects.



### Steps to return the objects

#### (iii) Order for submission



#### Within 2 weeks

(iv) Submission of the "log" (to a determination officer who confirms the documents and to an investigator)



#### Within 6 weeks

- (v) The determination officer confirms the documents.
- (vi) Specified Communication documents that satisfy the requirements are immediately returned.
