# Cease and Desist Orders • Payment Orders



☐ The number of cease and desist orders : 12 cases

☐ The total payment orders: 875million US \$ (new high)

# Elimination of price-fixing cartels bid-rigging



#### ☐ JFTC protects consumer interest,

# by eliminating price-fixing cartels and bid riggings.

- > The market size of 10 legal measures is 4400 million US \$ in total.
- > The fields closely relating to people's living are also protected.
- Sovernment-Assisted Bid Rigging, in which officials working for central/local government offices harm public interest, is also included.

# A large impact of the leniency program 2

  - → The size of price-fixing cartel cases enlarges.
- ☐ Legal measures against price-fixing cartels

# Elimination of the acts that avoid competition in the distribution sector



- ☐ JFTC ensures the opportunity of consumers to compare prices.
  - Cease and Desist Order against Johnson & Johnson K.K. (Dec. 2010)
  - ➤ Johnson & Johnson forced its partner retailers not to display the selling price for contact lenses in their advertisements.
  - The opportunities for consumers to compare prices were remarkably missed because the price competition among partner retailers was avoided.

#### Elimination of abuse of superior bargaining position



### ☐ Strictly coping with infringement.

➤ Cease and Desist Order against Royal Home Center Co. Ltd, returning goods and coercing the suppliers of goods into dispatching employees unreasonably. (Jul. 2010)

#### Prevention of the acts that cause unfair disadvantages to SMEs.

- Establishment of "Task Force against abuse of Superior Bargaining Position Cases" (Nov. 2009)
- Efficient and effective investigation
- Cautions are issued to large-scale retailers whose practice whose actions might raise a problem

# Elimination of unjust low price sales



- ☐ Prevention of the acts that cause unfair disadvantages to SMEs.
  - ➤ Basically, the investigation should be within 2 months, and cautions are issued to entrepreneurs whose actions may lead to infringements before disadvantages actually occur .
