

JFTC holds the Training Course for Vietnam Competition Authority and Vietnam
Competition Council on the Antimonopoly Act and Competition Policy

The Japan Fair Trade Commission (JFTC) will hold the 8th Training Course for the Vietnam Competition Authority (VCA) and the Vietnam Competition Council (VCC) on the Antimonopoly Act and Competition Policy from November 12 to 29, 2012 in Tokyo and Hyogo, in cooperation with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

The training course will be held to provide officials of the VCA and the VCC with an opportunity to obtain the knowledge on Japanese Antimonopoly Act and its enforcement, with the purpose of contributing to the enhancement and the proper enforcement of the competition law in Vietnam. The JFTC has held the series of training courses for the VCA since 2009.

Meanwhile, the JFTC has dispatched its staff as long-term expatriate experts to the VCA since September 2008. The experts provide technical cooperation to the VCA.
