JFTC holds the 10th Training Course for Indonesian Competition Authority on the Antimonopoly Act and Competition Policy

The Japan Fair Trade Commission (JFTC) will hold the 10th Training Course for the Indonesian competition authority (Kosimi Pengawas Persaingan Usaha (KPPU)) on the Antimonopoly Act and Competition Policy from February 4 through 22, 2013 in Tokyo, Osaka, and Kobe, in cooperation with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).
