

The JFTC holds Training Course for Sector Regulators in the Philippine on the  
Antimonopoly Act and Competition Policy

The Japan Fair Trade Commission (JFTC) will hold the training course for Sector Regulators in the Philippine on the Antimonopoly Act and competition policy on February 4th, 2016 in Tokyo, in cooperation with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

The training course takes place to provide officials of Sector Regulators in the Philippine and others with opportunity to obtain the knowledge on the Antimonopoly Act and competition policy, with the purpose of supporting the enhancement of competition legislation and law enforcement in the Philippine.
