

The JFTC holds Training Course for the Authority for Fair Competition and Consumer Protection of Mongolia on the Antimonopoly Act and Competition Policy

The Japan Fair Trade Commission (JFTC) will hold the training course for the Authority for Fair Competition and Consumer Protection of Mongolia (AFCCP) on the Antimonopoly Act and competition policy from January 12nd to 15th, 2016 in Tokyo, in cooperation with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

The training course takes place to provide officials of the AFCCP and others with opportunity to obtain the knowledge on the Antimonopoly Act and its enforcement, with the purpose of supporting the enhancement of competition legislation and law enforcement in Mongolia.

2. Venue: JFTC headquarters (Tokyo)
3. Participants: 13 AFCCP officials and others
4. Organizers: JFTC and JICA
5. Contents: Lectures by academicians on the Antimonopoly Act and competition policies; lectures by JFTC officials on investigation procedures; etc.
