JFTC issues a cease and desist order to used car dealerships in Aichi Prefecture on misleading representations by odometer-tampering

5 November 2003 Japan Fair Trade Commission

The JFTC, following an investigation into two used car dealerships, Universal World Corporation and Mr. SAKOU Hitoshi (shop name: Trade in Automobile), today issued a cease and desist order finding that violation of Section 4 (1) (misleading representation on quality) of the Premiums and Representations Act existed.

## 1. Parties to receive the order

## 2. Outline of violation

(1)Universal World Corporation, in June 2003, made the following misleading representations to consumers on 9 used car in the shop:

The company tampered the odometers and displayed fake mileage in the shop and magazines.
