

JFTC holds the first Technical Training Course on the Antimonopoly Act
and Competition Policy for Indonesia

1. Outline of the Training Course

- (2) Participants: 10 officers of Indonesian Commission of the Supervisory of Business Competition (hereinafter KPPU (Kosimi Pengawas Persaingan Usaha))
- (3) Organizers: the JFTC, Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA)
- (4) Place: JICA Osaka International Center, Osaka

2. Backgrounds

In Indonesia, since the enactment of the Competition Act (the Act of Prohibition of Monopoly and Unfair Business Competition) in the year 2000, KPPU has worked implementation the Competition Act as independent government authority.

Under this circumstance, the Indonesian Government takes a great interest in the JFTC 's experience concerning the Antimonopoly Act and competition policy, and requests instruction and advice on the Indonesian competition act and its enforcement. In response to their needs, the JFTC is going to hold the Training Program for officers of KPPU which is in charge the sector. We will hold the Program from FY2003 to FY2005.

3. Purpose and Effect of the Training Course

We hope that the Training Course will be an opportunity of getting knowledge of Antimonopoly Act and its implementation and be useful for effective enforcement of the competition laws in Indonesia.
