The JFTC provides the 9th Training on the Antimonopoly Act and Competition Policy to China.

2. The Purpose of this Training

National Congress of the Party held in October 1992 set the realization of "socialistic market economy" as a goal for economic revolution, and the 9th Five-Year Plan adopted in 1996 placed deepening economic revolution as one of the selected policies. Reflecting these movements, China is dealing with various issues such as establishment of modernized legislation regarding corporation, development of commodity market, and promotion of economic legislation. Concerning competition policy, procedure for legislation of a comprehensive competition law is now under way as a part of the economic revolution.

Under these circumstances, the Chinese government has shown strong interest in our experience in competition law and policy and requested the JFTC for instruction and consultation on the Antimonopoly Act as a whole. Responding to this request, the JFTC has provided training to Chinese officials dealing with competition law and policy since 1998. This year's training will be held as the attached program shows.

(Reference) In China, the Law Against Unfair Competition was enacted in 1993 where it prohibits tie-in sale, unjustifiable premium, bid-rigging, and so on. Moreover, the Pricing Law, which prohibits price-fixing was enacted in 1997, and the Provisional Regulation on Prohibiting Monopolistic Pricing was established in 2003, based on the Pricing Law. At present, the draft Antimonopoly Act is deliberated in the Standing Committee of the National People's Committee.
