2. Backgrounds

In Indonesia, since the enactment of the competition law (the Act of Prohibition of Monopoly and Unfair Business Competition) in 2000, the KPPU has worked on reinforcing implementation of the competition law as an independent governmental agency.

Under this circumstance, the Indonesian Government has shown a strong interest in the JFTC’s experience concerning the Antimonopoly Act and competition policy, and requested instruction and consultation on the competition law and its enforcement. In response to the request, the JFTC has held the Training Course for officials of the KPPU who engage in these areas once every year since FY2003. This fiscal year is the fourth year for the Training Course.

3. Purpose

It is expected that the Training Course will be an opportunity for the KPPU’s officials to acquire knowledge of the Japanese Antimonopoly Act and its enforcement and therefore, contribute to effective enforcement of the competition law in Indonesia.
